

# Home Learning Ideas

## Weather Focus

Keep a diary of the weather on a weekly basis.  
Can you find out how much rain falls in our country at this time of year? What is the wettest time of year? Can you compare our weather to weather of different countries?

## Maths

Continue with practising mental addition and subtraction. Try using two two or three digit numbers for a challenge.

Children should be able to calculate the doubles of all numbers to 20 and the related halves.

Practise telling the time to the quarter hour and moving on to telling the time to 5 minute intervals.

Learning multiplication facts for the 2, 5 and 10 time tables.

Identify odd and even numbers up to 50.

Count forwards and backwards in 2s, 5s and 10s to 100.

Encourage children to make totals up to £1.00 using different coins.

If you need any further advice with how to support your child in Maths, please come and speak to your child's Maths teacher.


## English

This half term children are focusing on nouns, verbs, adverbs and adjectives in descriptive language.

Whenever you read stories with your child try to get them to up level the words that are used in the stories i.e. loud, red car becomes purring, scarlet Ferrari. Can they generate their own describing words for characters and settings?

Children should be using punctuation correctly including commas, question marks and exclamation marks.

Please continue to encourage neat, cursive handwriting.
