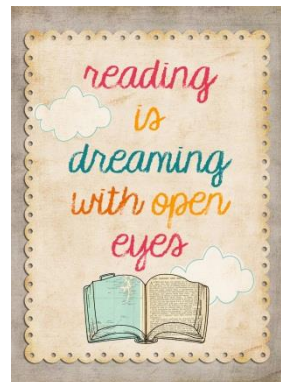
Attached to this letter is your child's first reading record. At Stamshaw, we recognise that learning to read is one of the most important skills your child will ever learn.
