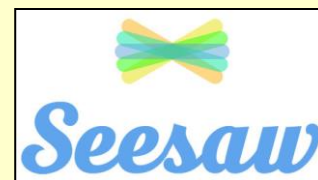
School term finishes, you may collect your children from 1pm.
