



Early Years Home Learning WB 12.10.20

This week we will be having an 'Autumn' week. We will be thinking about the signs of autumn, writing about what we see in autumn in literacy, using conkers to help us count in maths and making a leaf wreath in art.

Literacy

In literacy we will be painting an autumn tree using our hands and fingers to be the tree and leaves. After we have painted a tree we will write words to describe the tree, e.g. red, soft and crunchy.

You could draw or paint a tree and write words about the autumn leaves.



Maths

We will be learning how to count out objects and compare groups in maths this week.

We are going to use conkers to help us. If you don't have any conkers you could use any objects you have at home.

Make some number cards or use some number cards if you already have some at home. Pick one number card and count out that many objects onto the card. Pick another number card and count out that many objects onto the card. Look at the two groups of objects, discuss which one has more.





Phonics

This week we will continue learning phonics. We will look at the letters 'T' and 'P' and learn their names, sounds, action and how to write them.

You could look at Geraldine Giraffe videos for the sounds 'T' and 'P' on YouTube.

Look for objects around your house that start with these sounds, e.g. tiger, paint, tomato, pear.

This week in art we will be making a leaf wreath. To make the leaf wreath we will use leaves and paint to print onto a leaf template. When we have made enough we will cut them out and make them into a leaf wreath.

You could make one at home with your family and hang it on your door.
