

Early Years Home Learning WB 5.10.20

This week we will be learning about positional language in maths, story sequencing in literacy, drawing portraits in art and begin learning phase 2 phonic sounds.

Try the activities below at home, you can get a grown up to help you.

Literacy

In literacy we will be looking at sequencing parts of a familiar story in order. We have been reading the story 'We're Going on a Bear Hunt.'

Enjoy time sharing a story with a grown up at home. You could read a familiar book, your favourite book or a new book. After you have read the story you could discuss the story and your favourite part. You could have a conversation about the order of the story.



Art

We will be learning how to draw portraits of a friend in art. Draw a picture of someone in your family. Look closely at the details on their face, the colour of their hair and eyes. You could ask them to draw a portrait of you and sit opposite each other whilst you both draw.



Maths

This week we will be learning to use positional language and describe the position of objects.

Use a toy or teddy to help you use positional language. You could ask a grown up to give you instructions to follow, e.g. put the teddy on top of the table, put the teddy under the chair. You could also put the teddy somewhere and describe where it is.




Phonics

This week we will start learning phonics. We will look at the letters 'S' and 'A' and learn their names, sounds and how to write them.

You could look at Geraldine Giraffe videos for the sounds 'S' and 'A' on YouTube.

Look for objects around your house that start with these sounds, e.g. socks, apple, soap, ambulance.
