Throughout this new and exciting topic we will be researching different types of tree including deciduous and evergreen, looking closely at plant life identifying their features and exploring different animals who live in our local environment, in our homes and in woodland habitats.

Deciduous or evergreen? What can you find? Can you match a leaf to its tree? Can you match a petal to its flower?

Looking for educational games to play at home? Remember you can access these websites through our school website!



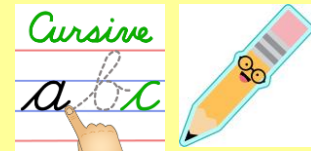
Maths
